
Chestnut Woods Association, LLC ("CWA") hereby petitions for leave to withdraw as an intervenor in the above-captioned case and substitute as intervenor an individual member of the Association, Mr. John Lawrence Hargrove.

In its timely petition to intervene in the present case, CWA requested that the Commission make an exception in CWA's case to the requirement of §150-1-12.7 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure that parties be represented by an attorney at law, and that CWA be permitted to appear *pro se*. The Commission denied that request, and CWA has concluded that retaining an attorney for this purpose is not feasible. Hence the present petition to withdraw and substitute Mr. Hargrove as an individual intervenor. In its original petition, CWA noted that its land was in the near vicinity of the proposed wind power generating facility, and that it was concerned about deleterious effects of the proposed wind turbine array and transmission line on environmental, scenic, recreational, economic and cultural values in a large area of Pendleton County, including but not limited to adverse effects on CWA and its own land. As a member of CWA, and also as an individual landowner in the near vicinity of the project, Mr. Hargrove has interests identical to those of CWA, and has authorized CWA to request his substitution as an individual intervenor.

We believe the granting of this request would be in the interest of full participation by those whose interests may be affected by the proposed project, and ask the Commission's prompt and favorable consideration.


