

PETITION TO INTERVENE OF JOHN LAWRENCE HARGROVE

Pursuant to Commission Order of July 5, 2006 in the above-captioned case, and Rule 12.6.a of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, I hereby petition for leave to intervene in the above-captioned case.

Petitioner's position and interest: For thirty-six years, jointly with my wife, Ann Hughes Hargrove, I have owned a farm located within approximately three miles or less of the site of the proposed industrial wind generating facility. For thirty four years I have owned an individual interest Chestnut Woods Association, LLC, which owns land located within approximately three miles or less of the proposed industrial wind generating facility. The proposed turbines will be visible from various points on these lands.

Grounds for proposed intervention: The proposed industrial wind generating facility will have deleterious effects on environmental, scenic, recreational, economic and cultural values in a large area of Pendleton County, including but not limited to adverse effects on land in which I have an ownership interest. These adverse effects include, but are not limited to, degradation of the daytime and/or nighttime viewshed of lands in which I have an ownership interest.

Relief desired: Petitioner seeks denial of the authorization that Liberty Gap, LLC seeks to construct a wind generating facility on Jack Mountain.


