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Gentlemen:

The Pendleton County Commission respectfully requests that the Public Service Commission grant Liberty Gap's Petition To Reconsider the above application. A decision on the merits will provide the opportunity for those who support the project and those who are opposed to the project to provide evidence which will allow the Public Service Commission to make an informed decision.

As we have previously stated, the Pendleton County Commission supports this project because of the positive impact it will have on Pendleton County and this area of the State. The Commission has entered into a written agreement with Liberty Gap which guarantees tax revenues in

the amount of not less than \$200,000.00 per year and a community partnership grant starting at \$110,000.00 per year and eventually increasing to a \$125,000.00 per year. This revenue is very important to Pendleton County. Also, the project will provide construction and permanent employment opportunities, direct and indirect expenditures, and substantial payments to landowners for the use of their property.

Because of the positive financial impact to Pendleton County and to the citizens thereof, we urge the Public Service Commission to timely reconsider its decision and reinstate the application. A hearing on the merits will allow the Public Service Commission to make a decision based upon the evidence of all interested parties.
