Application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity Authorizing the Construction and Operation of a Wholesale Electric Generating Facility and Related Transmission Support Line of less than 200 kV and Associated Interconnection Facilities in Pendleton County, West Virginia

I am strongly opposed to the Public Service Commission of West Virginia Commissioners reconsideration of its July 24, 2006 Order to Dismiss the Liberty Gap Wind Force, LLC application to construct an industrial wind energy facility and related transmission support line in Pendleton County, West Virginia.

In my opinion, the Commissioners were correct in their assessment of Liberty Gap Wind Force, LLC's behaviors, motives and intentions throughout this application process and this petition for reconsideration must be denied.

Liberty Gap Wind Force, LLC (a.k.a. US Wind Force, LLC) permit application should have been a total embarrassment for the Venture Capitalists, major stockholders and investors of the project. Even a casual observer could see that Liberty Gap's application was so void of information that had the application been a fisherman's net, they could not have caught the Titanic.

I believe that most parties, except Liberty Gap and the handful of profiteers of a built project, believe that this is a sinking Titanic ... Liberty Gap obviously did not sharpen their pencils... they have struck a huge iceberg; a.k.a. the PSC siting regulations and the vast majority of Pendleton County citizen and landowners.
