I still OPPOSE the project. This is supplemental information to support my opposition!

I had briefly mentioned, in an earlier letter, that the site of the Wind Farce is in a military training area for pilots. Last week, we were "bombed and strafed" as several high speed, low flying MILITARY aircraft went up and down across the ridges in the Moyers area.

Although the minimum altitude is supposed to be over 500 feet, how many pilots watch their altimeters when they are flying at or near supersonic speeds, diving and swerving, across ridge lines?

How many pilots and planes should we lose before someone realizes that low flying, high speed planes can and will collide with rotating blades, describing an arc of 320 feet, on towers sticking over 400 feet into the air, just over some ridge on Jack Mountain?

The Defense Department should be consulted, and involved, in any decision.
