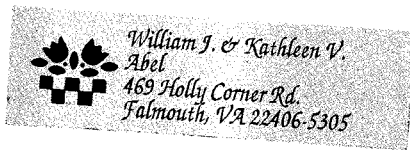


To Whom it my concern,
