

Dear Ms. Squire,

I am a resident landowner of Pendleton County, West Virginia and am writing to file an informal complaint with respect to the application made by Liberty Gap Wind Force for a Siting Certificate to construct and operate an electric wholesale generating facility, including transmission line. My concerns are in regards not only to me and my family but to all West Virginians. I am concerned that the blasting to prepare foundations for 50 or more wind turbines could adversely affect my water supply. My home is in close proximity to the proposed turbines. I am also concerned with the negative economic impact that these unsightly turbines will have on the value of my property. No provision for damage to my water supply has been given to me nor has an independent study of property values been implemented to alleviate our concerns. I have other concerns, such as, adverse affects to wildlife and to our environment. How will it affect our health? Major concerns that have not been addressed adequately. For the above reasons I ask that the Public Service Commission not give Liberty Gap Wind Force expedited consideration of their application until adequate studies of each area of concern be adequately done and without bias.

Thanks for your efforts on the public's behalf in protecting not only the rights of every resident of West Virginia but also in keeping our beautiful State, beautiful.
